Nationalization and Internationalization of CCP Curriculum Canadian View

Physician training

National physician competency profile, National curriculum, national Accreditation of training programs, local certification with opportunity to measure student against all students in Canada (LMCC)=nationalization of certification process and provincial Licensing body (C of P/S of BC)

Physician Assistant Training

International competency Profile (US –Can), local implementation of training programs needing accreditation by a National Accrediting body (CMA allied health), Students are locally certified and Nationally certified CAPA, all graduates will be provincially licensed

Paramedic Training

National competency profile, Nationally accredited training schools, local certification, There is no National Certification Process, Licensing is provincial
