CERTIFICATION IS DESIGNED TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC

Components of a valid certification

- I. Candidate completes an "approved" education program
- 2. Candidate meets qualification requirements (entry requirements)
- 3. Candidate meets initial certification requirements
 - a) Cognitive examination
 - b) Psychomotor validation
 - c) Affective validation
- 4. Certificant demonstrates continued competency

CERTIFICATION DOES

- Guarantee safe and effective practice
- Provides recognition of achievement

CERTIFICATION IS NOT

- Overviewed or connected to any trade association
- Conduct investigations regarding incompetent practice

TASKS WITHIN A THEORETICAL MODEL

- Board reviews and modifies theoretical model
- Adopt Strategic Plan to create Internationally recognized Certification
- Engage lead investigator
- Identify Practice Analysis Committee
- Select a national education program approval process
- Updates examination after adoption of new Practice Analysis
- Determine methods candidates will validate certification qualifications
- Adopt re-certification requirements for the CP-C.
- Develop "transition" policy to grandfather current CP-Cs

FRAMEWORK

- IBSC partners with agency that "approves" education programs
- Candidates meets qualifications requirements
- Candidates meets initial certification requirements
- Candidate receives a passing score on a cognitive examination
- Presents written validation the candidate meets entry-level psychomotor competency via the education program possession of a psychomotor portfolio
- Presents written validation the candidate possess program identified affective requirements
- Certificant maintains certification

NEXT STEPS

Full realization regarding the components of certification take years to come to fruition.

- Board adopts developmental process
- Framework committee meets: assigns tasks to committee's
- Committee's report, October 2018
- Board adopts committee reports

FINAL THOUGHTS

- This initiative does not discount the IBSC work to date, but moves the CP-C process forward by peer reviewed research validating the subspecialty.
- The framework must be communicated to the international EMS community
- Partners are necessary to promulgate CP-C certification worldwide

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
