



Master of Health Practice in Paramedicine

180 points from: 120 points from Postgraduate

Diploma in Health Science in Paramedicine; and

60 points from HEAL997 Practice Project; or

45 points from HEAL986 Research in Practice

A total 15 points of coursework from PHMY801 Pharmacology Science or PHMY802 Pharmacotherapeutics

Master of Health Science 240 points from:

120 points from Postgraduate Diploma in Health Science in Paramedicine; and

120-point thesis;

or

90-point thesis and 30 points coursework

A total 30 points of research is required, ie. HEAL811 plus either HEAL808 or HEAL810 (15pts)

Master of Philosophy 120 point thesis:
